SUBJECT: CORRECTION TO AMENDMENT NOS. 85 AND 46 (TAC NOS. M89956 AND M89957)

Dear Mr. Hunger:

On January 20, 1995, the Commission issued Amendment No. 85 to Facility Operating License No. NPF 39 and Amendment No. 46 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-85 for the Limerick Generating Station, Units 1 and 2, in response to your application dated July 20, 1994, as supplemented September 23, 1994.

These amendments raised the Steam Leakage Detection system set-points that isolate the High Pressure Coolant Injection system (HPCI) and Reactor Core Isolation Cooling (RCIC) system equipment on high equipment room temperature and high delta temperature. The amendments are supported by a Limerick Generating Station modification to increase the environmental qualifications limits of the HPCI and RCIC systems to allow the systems to remain operable when equipment room cooling is unavailable.

It has been brought to our attention that page 2 to both Amendments 85 and 46 did not specify that the amendment is to be implemented within 30 days of the date of issuance. Enclosed is a corrected page 2 of Amendment 85 and Amendment 46. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may have created.


