

## MEETING REPORT

Purpose: To discuss environmental data needed by NRC to develop an environmental impact statement (EIS) for decommissioning activities at the U.S. Army (Army) Jefferson Proving Ground (JPG) Site Decommissioning Management Plan (SDMP) site

### Background:

Because the Army is proposing license termination under conditions of restricted use, the NRC is required to prepare an EIS to assess the environmental impacts of decommissioning the JPG SDMP site. On January 25, 2001, the NRC staff sent the Army a letter entitled "Listing of Potential Discussion Areas for the Jefferson Proving Ground Environmental Report" (ADAMS accession number ML010170140). The letter was provided to assist the Army in its development of the environmental report (ER) to be submitted to NRC. The Army was then invited to participate in an open meeting at NRC headquarters to further discuss the information that should be included in the ER.

### Discussion

The Army presented a proposed outline for its ER (Attachment B). NRC staff discussed the content of the ER and answered questions from the Army. It was decided that a telephone conference should be held every two weeks between the Army and NRC to discuss the progress of the report.

### Action Items

1. Tom McLaughlin will clarify the scope of the area that the license incorporates and report the information to Joyce Kuykendall by June 11, 2001.
2. Tom McLaughlin will determine if the bridge line for teleconferences with NRC can be accessed internationally and report to Joyce Kuykendall by June 11, 2001.
3. Joyce Kuykendall will schedule a teleconference with NRC every two weeks, starting June 19, 2001, to discuss the status of the ER development.

4. Joyce Kuykendall and Tom McLaughlin will review the JPG files to determine if depleted uranium levels in deer tissue has been reported and will discuss their findings on June 19, 2001.
5. Joyce Kuykendall will submit the ER to NRC by October 31, 2001.
