**SUBJECT:** Request for an Extension of Time to Respond to Notice of Violation

Dear Mr. Randolph:

This refers to your letter, dated May 17, 2001, in response to the Notice of Violation (NOV) and Proposed Imposition of Civil Monetary Penalty sent to you by our letter, dated May 14, 2001. The NOV and Proposed Civil Penalty in the amount of \$55,000 was issued for a Severity Level III violation related to discrimination against a Wackenhut Corporation security officer and a training instructor for having engaged in protected activity.

In your May 17, 2001 response, you indicated that you have submitted a request under the Freedom of Information Action (FOIA). You requested a 60 day extension from receipt of the materials requested under the FOIA to respond to the NOV. Based on your FOIA request, the NRC agrees that an extension of time to respond to the NOV is appropriate and grants your request for an extension.
