SUBJECT: Fort Calhoun Station Licensing Action Estimates

In accordance with Reference 2, the Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) has estimated the number of licensing actions anticipated for the remainder of the Fiscal Year 2001 and the entire Fiscal Year 2002.

For the remainder of Fiscal Year 2001, three new submittals are planned and will very likely include the transfer of the operating license to a joint operating company to be submitted in August or September 2001.

For the Fiscal Year 2002, presently fourteen requests for license amendments are planned. These will include one license renewal request, one exemption, two requests for relief from inspection and surveillance requirements, one topical report submitted on a plant-specific basis and perhaps two other licensee requests requiring NRC review and approval are anticipated.

Complex reviews are anticipated on the license transfer to be submitted in Fiscal Year 2001, and the Fiscal Year 2002 submittals on the license renewal application and possibly on license amendments concerning: 1) Pressure Temperature Limits Report, 2) Changing Containment Closure Requirements During Fuel Handling or Heavy Loads Movements and 3) license changes associated with the Alternate Source Term Radiological Consequences submittal which is presently under NRR review. Other amendments and relief requests are not anticipated to require more than normal NRR review for routine license amendments.


Estimates of the potential safety and operational benefits, costs/man-rem averted and economic savings that would be realized by these licensing action requests have not been prepared.
