SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

Dear Ms. Frazier:

This is in reference to your letter dated February 4, 2000, in which you requested a copy of your transcribed interviews with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) Office of Investigations (OI), any other transcribed interviews which address your involvement in the investigation, and a copy of OI Report 2-98-023 to support your participation at the closed, predecisional enforcement conference the NRC intends to hold with Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA). The interviews were conducted as part of the investigation associated with OI Report 2-98-023.

The NRC requested your presence at the closed, predecisional enforcement conference by letter to TVA dated January 31, 2000, to assist us in fully understanding all relevant facts. Although no enforcement action is contemplated against you at this time, the transcripts of your OI interviews are being provided to you (Enclosure 1) because you may be subject to future enforcement action due to your involvement in the events that were the subject of the investigation.

The NRC is, however, declining your request for the release of any other transcribed interviews which address your involvement in the investigation and OI Report 2-98-023. In lieu of disclosing the full OI report and exhibits, the NRC's practice is to prepare a summary of the information which forms the basis for the staff's conclusions prior to a conference. Such a summary was enclosed with our January 31, 2000, letter to TVA which provided notification of our intent to conduct a closed, predecisional enforcement conference. A copy of our letter to TVA is included as Enclosure 2 for your information.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," this letter will not be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
