The Atomic Energy Commission (the Commission) having found that:

- A. The application for amendment, dated December 20, 1972, complies with the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
- B. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
- C. Prior public notice of proposed issuance of this amendment is not required since the amendment does not involve significant hazard considerations different from those previously evaluated.

Accordingly, Facility Operating License No. DPR-28 issued to Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation is hereby amended by revising paragraph 2B thereof in its entirety to read:

- B. Pursuant to the Act and 10 CFR Part 70, "Special Nuclear Material," to receive, possess, and use at any one time up to 3300 kilograms of U-235 and 16 grams of plutonium in connection with the operation of the facility.

This amendment is effective as of the date of issuance.
