SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JUNE 6, 2001, TELECOMMUNICATION WITH VIRGINIA  
ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY AND DUKE ENERGY CORPORATION ON  
THE INTEGRATED INSPECTION SCHEDULE

On June 6, 2001, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff had a conference call with representatives of Virginia Electric Power Company and Duke Energy Corporation to discuss the integrated inspection schedule for the license renewal inspection activities planned for North Anna, Surry, Catawba, and McGuire facilities. Enclosure 1 is the list of participants in the conference call.

As a result of the discussion that took place during this conference call, the following tentative schedule for the inspection activities has been developed:

### **North Anna and Surry**

Scoping Methodology Audit: The scoping methodology audit is currently scheduled for the week of September 10, 2001.

Scoping Inspection: The scoping inspection for North Anna, Units 1 and 2, and Surry, Units 1 and 2, will take place at the Virginia Electric Power Company corporate facility in Glen Allen, Virginia, during the week of February 4, 2002. If additional time is needed, the inspection may continue into the week of February 11, 2002. In addition, if inspection activities make it necessary to visit each site, the applicant will make arrangements for the inspection team to visit each facility during this time frame.

Aging Management Inspection: The aging management inspection for North Anna, Units 1 and 2, and Surry, Units 1 and 2, will take place during the weeks of May 6, 2002, and May 20, 2002. If additional time is needed, additional time will be scheduled toward the end of the second week of inspection.

In addition, members of the inspection team will visit the North Anna and Surry nuclear power stations for approximately three days to perform system walkdowns during September 2001 and April 2002, respectively.

## **Catawba and Mc Guire**

Scoping Methodology Audit: The scoping methodology audit is currently scheduled for the week of October 15, 2001.

Scoping Inspection: The scoping inspection for Catawba Units 1 and 2, and McGuire, Units 1 and 2, will take place at the Duke Energy Corporation corporate facility in Charlotte, North Carolina, during the week of March 18, 2002. If additional time is needed, the inspection may continue into the week of March 25, 2002. In addition, if inspection activities make it necessary to visit each site, the applicant will make arrangements for the inspection team to visit each facility during this time frame.

Aging Management Inspection: The aging management inspection for Catawba Units 1 and 2, and McGuire, Units 1 and 2, will take place during the weeks of July 8, 2002, and July 22, 2002. If additional time is needed, additional time will be scheduled toward the end of the second week of inspection.

In addition, members of the inspection team will visit the McGuire and Catawba nuclear power stations for approximately three days to perform system walkdowns during March 2002 and May 2002, respectively.

This schedule is subject to change based on availability of staff resources. Upon identifying a need to change any of the proposed dates, the staff will inform the applicant immediately. If an applicant needs a change in the schedule, they should contact their project manager and Caudle Julian of Region II, immediately.

A draft of this phone conversation summary was provided to Virginia Electric Power Company and Duke Energy Corporation to allow them the opportunity to comment prior to the summary being issued.
