

The purpose of this modification is to: (1) exercise Option Year 3, thereby extending the period of performance for 12 months, (2) increase the total contract ceiling amount of the contract by \$131,704.00, and (3) provide incremental funding in the amount of \$40,000.00, thereby increasing the obligated amount of the contract from \$317,899.00 to \$357,899.00. Accordingly, the contract is hereby modified as follows:

1. Subsection B.3, "CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION—COST PLUS FIXED FEE (JUN 1988)," the total estimated cost of this contract is increased by \$122,048.00 from \$369,603.00 to \$491,649.00, and the obligated amount is increased from \$317,899.00 to \$357,899.00. Therefore, paragraphs (g) and (h) under this subsection are DELETED in their entirety and the following paragraphs are SUBSTITUTED in lieu thereof:

"(g) The amount currently obligated by the Government with respect to this contract is \$357,899.00."

"(h) The total contract ceiling amount for full performance of the base year (\$122,857.00), Option Year 1 (\$115,042.00), Option Year 2 (\$131,703.00), and Option Year 3 (\$122,048.00) of this contract is \$491,649.00. Of which the amount of \$458,629.00 represents the estimated reimbursable cost and the amount of \$33,022.00 represents the fixed fee."

2. Under Subsection F.4, "DURATION OF CONTRACT PERIOD (MAR 1987), ALTERNATE (MAR 1987)," the expiration date is extended for an additional 12 months. Therefore, the two sentences under this subsection are deleted in their entirety and the following are substituted in lieu thereof:

"This contract shall commence on August 1, 1998 and shall expire on July 31, 2002. The term of this contract may be extended at the option of the Government for an additional one, one-year period."

An updated SCA Wage Determination has been requested from the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL). When received, if the updated Wage Determination is a newer revision than the one currently in this contract, the Contracting Officer will forward this document to the Contractor for action in accordance with FAR Clause 52.222-43.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
