The Nuclear Regulatory Commission is considering issuing an amendment to Facility Operating License No. NPF-42 for the Wolf Creek Generating Station (WCGS). The amendment consists of proposed changes to the antitrust conditions in the operating license.

It is my understanding that your section was involved in the development of the antitrust conditions imposed on Kansas Gas & Electric when the operating license for WCGS was issued on June 4, 1985. Because of that, I am requesting your comments on the proposed changes to these conditions. A copy of the application for license amendment dated June 27, 2000 (identifying the changes), and the supplemental letters dated January 31 and May 2, 2001 (identifying the changes and the justification for each change), provided by Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC) is enclosed.
