By letter dated December 4, 2000, RG&E responded to RIS 2000-20, "Importance of Industry Providing NRC Advance Notice of Intent to Pursue License Renewal". That response was submitted as a proprietary document in accordance with 10CFR2.790, since RG&E was still evaluating the feasibility of preparing a License Renewal Application.

We have now concluded that it is no longer necessary to treat our December 4, 2000 submittal as proprietary in accordance with 10CFR2.790. As noted in the December 4 letter, our current plan is to prepare a parallel application with Wisconsin Electric Power Company's Point Beach Nuclear Plant, to be completed by July 2002. Assuming a positive outcome to the License Renewal Application process and subsequent approval by our Boards of Directors, RG&E and WEPCO currently anticipate submitting a License Renewal Application at the same time to the NRC during the second half of 2002.
