Relief Request No.26

Section V, "Alternative Examination"

Please provide the time-interval at which you will ensure the integrity of the seals and gaskets of the bolted penetrations by (1) leak-rate testing, and (2) visual examination, as required by Appendix J, Title 10, *Code of Federal Regulations*, Part 50, which provides licensees the flexibility in scheduling Type B leak-rate.
