 SUBJECT: PROPOSED FEES & HEARING DATE

We are proposing to adjust our annual fees for radioactive materials licenses to meet necessary program costs. At this time we are proposing an approximate 2.87% increase in our fees for all Radioactive Materials Licenses including the "hourly rate" charged for certain unusual activities such as monitoring of environmental clean-up projects and special evaluations of sealed sources and devices. (The increase is the maximum allowed under Initiative 601 and does not fully cover recent budget increases; in particular, the legislatively approved salary increase of 8% for technical staff.) The proposed increase is needed to maintain the current level of program services.

A summary of the proposed radioactive materials license fees is attached. The full text of the proposed fee change is being published in the Washington State Register (WSR 01-11-160) along with other fees being adjusted by Environmental Health Programs. These include fees for decontamination of illegal drug sites, water system evaluation and project review and approval fees, shellfish program certification fees, water works certification fees, and our radioactive materials license fees.

A public hearing on the proposed Environmental Health Programs fees will be held on June 27, 2001, at 9 AM in Building 2 (note: this building is two buildings diagonally to the northeast of Building 5), 7171 Cleanwater Lane, Tumwater, Washington (Exit 101 from I-5, go 1 mile east on Airdustrial Way, turn left on Cleanwater Lane, left at second drive). Comments must be received by June 27, 2001, to assure consideration. The new fee schedule would take effect for radioactive materials licensees with due dates after August 1, 2001.
