SUBJECT: OFFICE REVIEW OF PROPOSED RULE ON MATERIAL CONTROL
AND ACCOUNTING AMENDMENTS (10 CFR PARTS 51, 61, 70, 72, 73,
73, 75, 76, and 150)(RIN AG69)

The Rules and Directives Branch has reviewed the attached rulemaking package concerning material control and accounting amendments. I concur for the Office of Administration in the draft Commission paper and Federal Register notice, with the changes as marked on the attachment.

We have revised the summary statement so that it more clearly meets the requirements of the Office of the Federal Register (OFR) as set out in 1 CFR 18.12. In addition, we have made changes to the amendatory language and codified text that are necessary to comply with OFR publication requirements concerning section designation.

A Regulatory History must be created for this proposed rule once it has been published in the Federal Register. The Regulatory History should be created in ADAMS. In the profile of each document related to the Regulatory History, use the Regulation Identifier Number (RIN) as the Case/Reference Number (RIN-AG69). This will make it easier to combine all the documents into a folder under ADAMS once the rule has been published.

When this document is forwarded for signature and publication, please have a member of your staff include a 3.5-inch diskette that contains a copy of the document in WordPerfect as part of the transmittal package. The diskette will be forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register and the Government Printing Office for their use in typesetting the document. Also, please include a copy of the Congressional letters on a diskette. This diskette will be forwarded to the Office of Congressional Affairs.
