SUBJECT: CLOSEOUT OF TAC NO. RELATED TO REVIEW OF REACTOR
VESSEL HEAD BORON DISCOVERY - OCONEE NUCLEAR STATION,
UNIT 2 (TAC NO. MB1812)

By memorandum dated April 30, 2001, the subject TAC number was opened to document oversight activities by the NRC related to the finding of boron on the reactor vessel head at Oconee Nuclear Station, Unit 2. The small amount of boron was found at the base of four control rod drive mechanisms. Three repair relief requests (TAC Nos. MB1895, MB1896, and MB1917) related to the American Society of Mechanical Engineers Code requirements were processed. Since the repairs and all review activities have been completed, this memorandum closes TAC No. MB1812. Attached are email messages that were transmitted between the licensee and the staff during the review process.
