SUBJECT: RESPONSIBILITY FOR FEDERAL POTASSIUM IODIDE (KI) POLICY

Dear Mr. Salter:

This letter follows up on our discussions regarding the roles and responsibilities, process, and time line for revision of the Federal KI Policy during our meetings on May 24 and 25, 2001. As we discussed, the responsible NRC organization for revising the Federal KI Policy has been transferred from Incident Response Operations (Joe Holonich) to the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (Glenn Tracy). This consolidates responsibilities for implementation of the Commission's decisions on KI under one NRC organization. All future correspondence and interface between FEMA and NRC on KI should be addressed to me or my staff on the NRC/FEMA KI subcommittee.

Additionally, I formally request that a FRPCC subcommittee be formed to foster timely and efficient revision of the policy. As we discussed during our previous meetings, the FRPCC committee should include the current NRC/FEMA KI subcommittee members as well as FDA and EPA representatives. I request that the initial meeting of this FRPCC KI subcommittee be held at the earliest opportunity.
