SUBJECT: MAY 6, 1983 CONFIRMATORY ORDER

On May 6, 1983, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued an Order Modifying the Licenses of Salem Nuclear Generating Station, Units 1 & 2. The Order required Public Service Electric and Gas Company (PSE&G) to implement and/or maintain the elements of its Corrective Action Program as described in your letter dated April 28, 1983.

By letter dated December 11, 1985, you indicated that the short-term, interim and long-term elements of the corrective action program had been completed and that the programs resulting from the implementation of the Order are now being routinely managed. You further requested that item C.10.a of the Corrective Action Program be terminated. This item required that the Nuclear Oversight Committee (NOC) provide quarterly reports of its review of the implementation of the program to NRC, and that PSE&G respond to these reports until the Director of Nuclear Reactor Regulation modified the requirement. You indicated that the purpose of the requirement, to provide timely information on the activities of the NOC as it monitored implementation of the Corrective Action Plan, has been fulfilled.

We have reviewed your request and the status of actions undertaken in conformance with the May 6, 1983 Order. We have concluded that the terms of the Order have been satisfactorily completed.

On the basis of the above review we have also concluded that the quarterly reports of the NOC and PSE&G no longer need be provided to the NRC. Therefore, as provided by its terms, the requirements of item C.10.a for submission to NRC of quarterly Nuclear Oversight Committee reports and responses by PSE&G within 30 days of such reports, are terminated.
