Dear Ms. Brock:

Duke Power is in the process of requesting an extension of the operating license for Catawba Nuclear Station from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). We are proposing to continue operation of the facility without any refurbishment activities. There are no known historic properties located on the site or immediately adjacent to the site. I have included a site location map to facilitate your review.

Due to the lack of refurbishment activities and the absence of historic properties, Duke Power does not believe that continued operation of the facility will affect historic properties. Accordingly, no additional activities will be required in order to comply with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
