Nuclear Regulatory Commissioners:

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I am appalled by the unprofessional and scurrilous behavior of the NRC Staff. As a petitioner with standing granted by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, I was never notified that the Staff had moved the date of public meeting for comments on the DSEIS for Turkey Point 38 days sooner than the printed schedule. All of my proffered contentions relate to the Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement. Not only had the Staff totally failed to notify me but they also did not notify Ms. Joette Lorion, the other petitioner, nor Dr. Jerry Brown who spoke against renewing the license at the DSEIS scoping hearing, December 6, 2000. The wrong date still appears on the NRC's license renewal website. This is a blatant ploy to "squeeze" the opposing public into a poor showing at the meeting by denying us essential information and reasonable time to prepare a credible case.

The meeting is only 36 days from now and I do not have the DSEIS ! Three days ago, June 8, 2001, I attended the inspection exit meeting held by the licensee, Ken Clark, and other personnel from Region II. Apparently the licensee and the NRC personnel were fully aware the public meeting date had been moved 38 days sooner.

This secret change has injured my participation in the hearing process. With all due haste, I need to have fifty ( $\underline{50}$ ) copies of the Turkey Point DSEIS sent directly to me. I also need a phone number where additional copies can be quickly sent, if needed. I must be sent an accurate revised calendar showing the dates of all events relating to license renewal proceedings for Turkey Point. I want to know the exact dates Region II personnel and licensee personnel were notified that July 17, 2001 was the date of the DSEIS public meeting.

While I was at the licensee/Region II inspection meeting, I brought attention to two serious but unverifiable stories. During steam generator repairs at Turkey Point, doorways had to be broken to accommodate the lower assemblies. Voids up to 4 feet in length were discovered in the concrete of a broken doorway. The second story related to the construction of the plant. A cement truck driver remembers that the long waiting lines forced the drivers to keep adding water, so the cement wouldn't harden before delivery. This could be the source of the large voids.

The possibility that either of these stories is true obligates responsible officials to begin extensive testing for voids throughout both containment buildings. Aging management assumptions of oxidation, hydration, crumbling, microbiotic action and faulting within containment walls need to be discarded if voids are found. Numerous repairs may be necessary. Would you please see to it that these issues are examined ? I have little reason to trust the Staff.
