Dear Mr. Campbell:

By letter dated November 1, 2000, Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station (DBNPS), Unit 1, submitted a proposed change to the Technical Specification (TS) Bases 3/4.7.1.1, TurbineCycle —Safety Valves (LAR 00-0004), which contains an administrative change. This change is being requested to remove extraneous text regarding Main Steam Safety Valve locations, setpoints, and capacities. The proposed administrative change affects only the TS Bases and is not related to any change to the TS.

Currently, the TS Bases 3/4.7.1.1 contains the following statements, which are proposed to be deleted:

These requirements are, respectively, met as follows:

- 1. Nine safety valves are installed per steam generator.
- 2. The relief capacity of two of the nine safety valves per steam generator is 583,574 lbs/hr each, and the capacity of the remaining seven is 845,759 lbs/hr each.
- 3. A minimum of two OPERABLE safety valves per steam generator, with a combined total relief capacity of at least 1,167,148 lbs/hr, one with a setpoint not greater than 1050 psig (± 1%), and one with a setpoint not greater than 1100 psig (± 1%).
- 4. The total relieving capacity of all safety valves on both main steam lines is 14,175,000 lbs/hr which is 120 percent of the total secondary system flow of 11,760,000 lbs/hr at 100 percent of RATED THERMAL POWER. A maximum safety valve setpoint pressure of 1100 psig (± 1%) assures main steam system pressure remains below 110 percent, or 1155 psig.

Since the statements being deleted do not constitute the basis for any TS Limiting Condition for Operation or Surveillance Requirement, they are not required in accordance with 10 CFR 50.36(a). Additionally, there exists equivalent information within the actual TS (3/4.7.1) or within the DBNPS Updated Safety Analysis Report (Section 5.2.2.3, "Overpressure Protection.").

This is considered an administrative change to the TS Bases consistent with the DBNPS Tss, and has no adverse effect on nuclear safety, and is therefore acceptable. Please replace the current TS Bases 3/4.7.1.1, page B 3/4 7-1, with the enclosed new TS Bases page.
