By letter dated April 17, 1990, Public Service Electric and Gas Company (PSE&G) requested withdrawal of an emergency license amendment request dated January 4, 1990. The January 4, 1990 request modified the charging pump flow requirements to allow Salem Unit 2 to complete the fourth fuel cycle with maximum charging pump flow exceeding the technical specification limit of 550 gpm by less than 1%. The fourth fuel cycle ended on April 1, 1990, when Salem 2 entered Mode 5.

By letter dated April 20, 1990, amendment 90 was issued for Salem Unit 2 in response to the January 4, 1990 request. Because the amendment was issued before receipt of the request for withdrawal, your request is denied.
