Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 2 to Construction Permit No. CPPR-135 and Amendment No. 2 to Construction Permit No. CPPR-136 issued to the Public Service Company of New Hampshire, The United Illuminating Company, Central Maine Power Company, Central Vermont Public Service Corporation, The Connecticut Light and Power Company, Fitchburg Gas and Electric Light Company, Montaup Electric Company, New Bedford Gas & Edison Light Company, New England Power Company, and Vermont Electric Power Company, Inc.
