SUBJECT: AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO CONSTRUCTION PERMITS FOR SEABROOK STATION
UNITS 1 AND 2

We are enclosing Amendment No. 2 to Construction Permit No. CPPR-135 and Amendment No. 2 to Construction Permit CPPR-136 for The Seabrook Station, Units 1 and 2. These Amendments authorize transfers of ownership interests to the Massachusetts Municipal Wholesale Electric Company (5.59249 percent) and to Maine Public Service Company (1.46056 percent).

The transfers authorized by Amendment No. 2 to the construction permits were requested by your letter of May 15, 1978, supplemented by your letter of October 16, 1978. Authorization was withheld in the issuance of Amendment No. 1 on December 27, 1978 because, as we stated in our letter of December 27, 1978, our antitrust review for the transfer of ownership interests to Massachusetts Municipal Wholesale Electric Company and to Maine Public Service Company had not been completed.

Also enclosed is a copy of a related notice which has been forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication.




