National Security Presidential Directive 1 established seventeen Policy Coordinating Committees (PCCs) to serve as interagency forums for interagency coordination of national security policy. I chair the Records Access and Information Security PCC, which has responsibility for issues related to classification and declassification of information, personnel security, and physical security, including most of the duties previously assigned to the Security Policy Board.

The PCC has established an interagency Personnel Security Working Group, which will be chaired by a representative of the Department of Justice, a Physical Security Working Group chaired by a Department of Defense representative, and a Classification Management Working Group chaired by the Director of the Information Security Oversight Office. We hope to include on each working group a representative of each agency significantly concerned with policies of personnel security, physical security, and information classification and declassification.

Please nominate senior representatives from your agency to serve on the Personnel Security Working Group, the Physical Security Working Group, and the Classification Management Working Group. Each nominee should have a broad perspective on your agency's programs in the respective area, and should be empowered to speak for your agency, so that decisions and policy recommendations can be made in an informed and timely manner. Because the Working Groups have already received several PCC taskings, I would appreciate receiving the names of your nominees by the close of business on July 6.
