SUBJECT: Web Addresses for Environmental Impact Statements

We have noted that some federal agencies are now making their environmental impact statements (EISs) available for review on the Web in order to improve public access to these documents. We believe that this practice is very useful and is likely to increase. We believe it is important that EPA support agencies in publicizing these websites.

Therefore, we have decided to include Web addresses of on-line EISs, when available, as part of EPA's weekly *Federal Register* notice of availability of EISs. We will start posting web addresses for EISs filed the week ending July 13, 2001; the notice of availability for these will be published July 20, 2001. EPA will reference the web address by adding the following to the Notice of Availability: "This document is available on the Internet at [website address]."

If your agency is interested in including the Web address of a specific EIS in EPA's weekly *Federal Register* notice, please ensure that the Web address is included in either the EIS cover sheet or the transmittal letter used to file the EIS with EPA.
