NOTIFICATION OF COMMITMENT REVISION

Reference: Letter from M. W. Rencheck (I&M) to U.S Nuclear Regulatory Commission Document Control Desk, "Response to Request for Additional Information, Technical Specification Change Request, Valve Position for Automatic Valves in the Auxiliary Feedwater System (TAC Nos. MB0292 and MB0293)," submittal C1100-08, dated November 10, 2000.

Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), the Licensee for Donald C. Cook Nuclear Plant (CNP) Units 1 and 2, is providing notification to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission of a commitment revision. In the referenced letter, I&M committed to submit a license amendment request to restore the 31-day frequency for technical specification (TS) surveillance requirements (SRs) 4.7.1.2.c and 4.7.1.2.d by June 30, 2001, and to maintain a 31-day frequency for the SRs until a license amendment was approved and implemented..

I&M is revising the commitment to submit a license amendment by a specific date. Instead, I&M has documented this TS deficiency in the CNP corrective action program and is processing it in accordance with Administrative Letter 98-10, "Dispositioning of Technical Specifications that are Insufficient to Assure Plant Safety." In accordance with its previous commitment, I&M will continue to perform the SRs at a 31-day frequency.
