SUBJECT: THIRD QUARTER FY-2001 UPDATE OF THE GENERIC ISSUE
MANAGEMENT CONTROL SYSTEM

The Generic Issue Management Control System (GIMCS) report is being revised to reflect the status of all unresolved generic issues as of June 30, 2001. Please provide me with the status of those issues assigned to your respective Divisions by making any necessary corrections or additions to the Second Quarter GIMCS Report (ML011210570) transmitted to you on May 1, 2001. The information provided on reactor generic issues will be used for the monthly report to Congress.

GIMCS is placed in the Public Document Room, for use by the public, and is provided to other government agencies. In addition, data collected in GIMCS is being used for the Safety Issues Management System to track generic issues through licensee implementation, where applicable. Therefore, it is important that the input provided be clear, concise, and accurate. For those issues that have a significant actual or potential schedule slippage or delay, the Problem/Resolution Section of the GIMCS data sheet should be used to identify the cause of the slippage and the actions taken, or to be taken, to prevent potential slippage or to reduce the effects of slippage.
