George:

If our direction and goal is to "address" the ACRS comments in the final report, I would expect a multi-year research effort to answer the questions raised. Some policy and strategy decisions need to be made with respect to the "relevance" of the ACRS comments, not just committing to address in final report. There is no way all the comments could be addressed in a literal sense, the present state of knowledge does not allow for it. Yet for the most part, I find it highly unlikely that any further specific knowledge identified would provide additional insights into the SFP decision.

This can be included in our discussions on response strategy.
