2.0 Status of Items Identified in Previous Reviews

3. The wording of the Current Status should be “notifying all licensees that perform licensed activities at temporary job-sites...” instead of the way it is worded in draft report.

3.1 Status of Materials Inspection Program

On Page 4, it was described that of the 21 inspections reviewed, only one inspection report was issued late. This inspection was conducted on 10-9-97 and was not a complete inspection of the facility. The rest of the inspection was performed 11-20-97, and the inspection report was sent out on 12-4-97, which is well inside of the 30 day criteria.


