We need to get together on how to present these issues at the exit. My recommendations are:

1. I'll present the overall process and how this fits into the process, Wayne will provide the findings and technical basis for the findings & Brian provides the overall message, i.e. lack of technical direction within the program.
2. In my introduction, I will
 - a. emphasis that this was a closely coordinated NRC effort that required significant, careful thought because this was a very difficult issue
 - b. describe the overall ROP process, i.e. report issues followed by a reg conference and a subsequent decision letter
 - c. describe the internal NRC process, i.e., interact with Con Edison risk folks, SDP panel to develop significance and characterize App B compliance issues ... provided enf guidance to McCaan
 - d. Significant public interest driving the need to quickly communicate to the public preliminary findings ... plan to have a letter out to Con Ed following summarizing the findings discussed in this exit meeting.
3. **Should not describe the violations in detail** because it is still being evaluated via the SDP panel and we may be vulnerable to criticism if the quicklook letter does not capture what may be viewed by the public as critical information that we gave Con Ed did not let the public in on it.
