This short letter is written to provide a correction to a typographical error appearing in our letter to you dated April 20, 2001 with Mail Control Number 259443. In **Section 8** titled **Surveys**, on **page 3**, the following sentence appears:

If surveying shall reveal a surface contaminated above 100 dpm/cm², cleanup and/or entry control procedures... will be initiated.

This sentence is in error and it should read as follows:

If surveying shall reveal a surface contaminated above 100dpm/100cm², cleanup and/or entry control procedures... will be initiated.

This letter should be a supplement to our initial letter dated April 20, 2001. This change helps to clarify the radiation survey procedure for our proposed project.
