THE LICENSEE SHALL MAINTAIN FOR INSPECTION BY THE CABINET RECORDS OF TRAINING RECEIVED BY INDIVIDUALS DESIGNATED AS RADIOGRAPHERS OR RADIOGRAPHERS' ASSISTANTS FOR FIVE (5) YEARS FOLLOWING THE LAST USE OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL BY THE INDIVIDUAL. THIS TRAINING PROGRAM IS APPLICABLE ONLY TO INDIVIDUALS WHO SHALL USE LICENSED MATERIAL UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THIS LICENSE.

14. THE RADIATION SAFETY OFFICER FOR THE ACTIVITIES AUTHORIZED BY THIS LICENSE IS KEN ROGERS .

15. THIS LICENSEE IS AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT LEAK TEST SAMPLES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURES DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSEE'S CORRESPONDENCE DATED MARCH 11, 1997 FOR ANALYSIS BY AMERSHAM .

ALTERNATIVELY, LEAK TEST SAMPLES MAY BE COLLECTED AND/OR ANALYZED BY OTHER PERSONS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY THE CABINET, U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION OR AN AGREEMENT STATE.

16. THE LICENSEE IS AUTHORIZED TO CALIBRATE RADIATION SURVEY INSTRUMENTATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH PROCEDURES DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSEE'S CORRESPONDENCE DATED MARCH 11, 1997 .

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17. THE LICENSEE SHALL CONDUCT A QUARTERLY PHYSICAL INVENTORY TO ACCOUNT FOR ALL SEALED SOURCES RECEIVED AND POSSESSED UNDER THE LICENSE. THE RECORDS OF THE INVENTORIES SHALL BE MAINTAINED FOR TWO (2) YEARS FROM THE DATE OF THE INVENTORY FOR INSPECTION BY THE CABINET, AND SHALL INCLUDE THE QUANTITIES AND KINDS OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, MANUFACTURER, LOCATION OF SEALED SOURCES, THE DATE OF THE INVENTORY, AND NAME OF THE INDIVIDUAL CONDUCTING THE INVENTORY.
18. SEALED SOURCES AUTHORIZED FOR A USE OTHER THAN RADIOGRAPHY SHALL BE TESTED AS RADIOGRAPHY SOURCES IN ACCORDANCE WITH 902 KAR 100:100 SECTION 6.
19. THE LICENSEE IS AUTHORIZED TO RECEIVE, POSSESS, AND USE SEALED SOURCES OF IRIDIUM-192 OR COBALT-60 WHERE THE RADIOACTIVITY EXCEEDS THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF RADIOACTIVITY SPECIFIED IN ITEM 8 OF THIS LICENSE PROVIDED:
- A. SUCH POSSESSION DOES NOT EXCEED THE QUANTITY PER SOURCE SPECIFIED IN ITEM 8 BY MORE THAN 20% FOR IRIDIUM-192 OR OR 10% FOR COBALT-60.
 - B. RECORDS OF THE LICENSEE SHOW THAT NO MORE THAN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF RADIOACTIVITY PER SOURCE SPECIFIED IN ITEM 8 OF THE LICENSE WAS ORDERED FROM THE SUPPLIER OR TRANSFEROR OF THE RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL; AND
 - C. THE LEVELS OF RADIATION FOR RADIOGRAPHIC EXPOSURE DEVICES AND STORAGE CONTAINERS DO NOT EXCEED THOSE SPECIFIED IN IN 902 KAR 100:100, SECTION 2.
20. PURSUANT TO 902 KAR 100, THE LICENSEE IS AUTHORIZED TO RECEIVE TITLE TO, POSSESS, USE, AND TRANSFER UP TO 999 KILOGRAMS OF URANIUM CONTAINED AS SHIELDING MATERIAL IN THE RADIOGRAPHY EXPOSURE DEVICES AND SOURCE CHANGERS AUTHORIZED BY THIS LICENSE.
21. THE LICENSEE MAY TRANSPORT RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, OR DELIVER RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL TO A CARRIER FOR TRANSPORT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF 902 KAR 100:070, AND OTHER DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY HAVING JURISDICTION.
22. IN ADDITION TO THE POSSESSION LIMITS IN ITEM 8, THE LICENSEE SHALL FURTHER RESTRICT THE POSSESSION OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL TO QUANTITIES BELOW THE MINIMUM LIMIT SPECIFIED IN 902 KAR 100:040, SECTION 15, FOR ESTABLISHING DECOMMISSIONING FINANCIAL ASSURANCE.

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23.
