SUBJECT: TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION AMENDMENT REQUEST ON REACTOR COOLANT
SYSTEM SUBCOOLING MARGIN MONITOR

Reference: Letter from H. B. Tucker to H. R. Denton dated February 10, 1986.

We are unable to provide a Federal Register Notice on your request to amend the Technical Specifications (TSs) on the reactor coolant system subcooling margin monitors. We have reviewed your application and have found it deficient because the no significant hazards consideration (NSHC) analysis and technical justification are inadequate.

10 CFR 50.91(a)(1) requires that licensees requesting an amendment provide an analysis using the standards in 10 CFR 50.92 (the three factor test) pertaining to NSHC. As mentioned above, it is difficult to draw the conclusion of NSHC on the summary that is offered. The basis for each of the three standards from 10 CFR 50.92(c) should be addressed separately and directly. Furthermore, we are unable to process the proposed changes because the "Technical Justification" for the proposed amendment is inadequate.

Approval of the proposed changes requires that you improve the NSHC portions and technical justification section. Therefore, you need to revise your February 10, 1986, proposal to include a NSHC which satisfies 10 CFR 50.91(a)(1). Pending a revised submittal correcting the above deficiencies, we propose to take no further action on your request. If you have any questions, contact Ms. Helen N. Furthermore, we will not be able to process the proposed changes until a more detailed "Technical Justification" section is provided.

Approval of the proposed changes requires that you improve the NSHC and technical justification portions of the amendment request.
