SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING HELD ON JUNE 26, 2001, WITH ENTERGY

OPERATIONS, INC., TO DISCUSS PLANNED POWER UPRATES BASED ON

REVISIONS TO 10 CFR Part 50, APPENDIX K

On June 26, 2001, a public meeting was held with various members of Entergy Operations, Inc. (Entergy), technical staff and Caldon, Inc. (Caldon), representatives to discuss Entergy's plans for requesting power uprates based on the provisions in revised 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix K. The meeting took place at the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) headquarters in Rockville, Maryland. The meeting was from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Entergy presented plans for power uprates at Grand Gulf Nuclear Station (GGNS), Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station, River Bend Station, and Waterford Steam Electric Station, Unit 3 (W3) to the NRC staff. Caldon representatives provided further information regarding the Caldon flow measurement device upon which the planned power uprates rely. A discussion followed regarding the planned power uprate schedule and the preliminary information provided by Caldon on their enhanced flow measurement technology. The NRC staff expressed a concern that a topical report for the new Caldon flow measurement device had not been submitted and could affect the proposed schedules for GGNS and W3. The NRC staff explained that review of the Caldon flow measurement device must be completed before completing the review of the power uprate requests. The NRC staff encouraged the Caldon representatives to submit the topical report for the new flow measurement device as soon as possible. The NRC staff also encouraged accelerated power uprate submittals for GGNS and W3, and emphasized the need for high quality submittals to reduce NRC review time.
