Subject: Technical Specification Amendment Request on Liquid Effluent
Monitors (TACS 63547/63548/63549)

Reference: Letter from H.B. Tucker to H.R. Denton dated September 12, 1986

We are unable to provide a Federal Register Notice on your request to amend the Technical Specification (TS) on the liquid effluent monitors. You state in your application that this submittal is a supplement to an August 27, 1986 application on gaseous effluents. Based on discussions with your staff and on our review, we conclude that the proposed liquid effluent monitor amendment is an independent action. Therefore, we find it deficient because you have not written a no significant hazards consideration (NSHC) and the technical justification is inadequate.

10 CFR Part 50.91(a)(1) requires that licensees requesting an amendment provide an analysis using the standards in 10 CFR Part 50.92 (the three factor test) pertaining to NSHC. We are unable to draw the conclusion of NSHC. The basis for each of the three standards from 10 CFR Part 50.92(c) should be addressed separately and directly. Furthermore, we will not be able to process the proposed changes until a more detailed "Technical Justification" section is provided.

Approval of the proposed changes requires that you include the NSHC and improve the Technical justification portions of the amendment request. Therefore, you need to revise the September 12, 1986 proposal to include a NSHC which satisfies 10 CFR Part 50.91(a)(1).
