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NRC TO MEET WITH ROCHESTER GAS & ELECTRIC CORPORATION TO DISCUSS PERFORMANCE AT R.E. GINNA NUCLEAR POWER PLANT

Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with representatives of Rochester Gas & Electric Corporation on Wednesday, June 20, to discuss the results of the agency's annual assessment of safety performance at the R.E. Ginna nuclear power plant.

The meeting, which will be open to the public for observation, is scheduled to begin at 1 p.m. in the Training Center at the plant, located on Lake Road in Ontario, N.Y. NRC officials will be available afterwards to answer questions.

The performance period to be discussed is April 1, 2000, to March 31, 2001. Overall, the NRC found that the plant operated in a manner that preserved public health and safety and fully met all cornerstone objectives during the period. A letter sent from the NRC Region I office to Rochester Gas & Electric addresses plant performance during the period and will serve as the basis for the meeting discussion.
