Purpose: Licensing Support Network Advisory Review Panel meeting to discuss issues concerning the design and operation of the Licensing Support Network (LSN)

Comments:

In 1998, the NRC's Rules of Practice in 10 C.F.R. Part 2, Subpart J, were modified to provide for the creation and operation of the Licensing Support Network (LSN) (63 FR 71,729 (Dec. 30, 1998)), an internet-based technological solution designed to address the submission and management of discovery records and documents relating to the licensing proceeding for the construction of a proposed geologic repository for the disposal of high-level radioactive waste (HLW). Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.1011(d), the agency has chartered the LSN Advisory Review Panel (LSNARP), a federal advisory committee that provides advice to the NRC on issues relating to LSN design, operation, maintenance, and compliance monitoring. At an August 8, 2001 meeting of the LSNARP, the principal presentation/discussion items will include an overview of recent revisions to 10 C.F.R. Part 2, Subpart J (66 FR 29,453 (May 31, 2001)); a review of the most recent LSN Administrator guidance materials and functional requirements, released June 13, 2001; a demonstration of the LSN web portal and associated software; a technical scenario presentation outlining what would be required to put a small participant system (e.g., 100 documents) on the web; and a presentation regarding a related NRC project to provide for electronic filing and exchange of adjudicatory documents. An opportunity also will be provided for discussion of any LSN-related items that LSNARP members would like to raise.

Additionally, on a first-come, first-served basis as time permits at the end of the LSNARP meeting, members of the public will be provided an opportunity to ask questions or make a brief oral statement regarding any LSN-related matter. Members of the public who would like to make a statement or otherwise comment regarding any LSN-related matter should advise the NRC contact listed above by phone or e-mail as soon as possible. Alternatively, members of the public may submit a written statement on any LSN-related matter to the contact addresses provided in the June 27, 2001 notice for this public meeting (66 FR 35,284 (July 3, 2001)).
