INTENT TO SUBMIT LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATIONS

Ladies and Gentlemen:

By letter dated August 29, 2000, Carolina Power & Light (CP&L) Company informed the NRC of plans to submit a license renewal application for the H. B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant (HBRSEP), Unit No. 2, during the fourth quarter of 2002. As a result of incorporating industry experience into our processes, the schedule for submitting the HBRSEP, Unit No. 2 license renewal application has been changed to June 2002. The HBRSEP, Unit No. 2 Operating License expires July 31, 2010.

By the same referenced letter, CP&L has established fourth quarter of 2004 as the planned submittal date for a license renewal application for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant (BSEP), Unit Nos. 1 and 2. The current schedule for the License Renewal Project at BSEP indicates that CP&L will submit the BSEP license renewal application to the NRC during the first quarter of 2004. The BSEP Unit Nos. 1 and 2 Operating Licenses expire September 8, 2016, and December 27, 2014, respectively.
