Dear Mr. Jackson:

Our letter of July 10, 2001 on the Holtec Quality Assurance Manual provided a summary of the enhancements in its Revision. 12 issue in relation to Revision 11. We also stated that the HI-STORM CoC amendment package submitted with our July 3, 2001 letter was prepared in verbatim compliance with Revision 11. We would like to add that all manufacturing activities on dry storage components covered by the CoCs issued by the NRC comply with Revision 11 of the Q.A. Manual. In addition ongoing and prior engineering design and analysis activities since the adoption of Revision 12 by the company (January of this year) have been assessed for conformance with Revision 11 and are being reconciled under the Corrective Action process specified in Section 16 of the Q.A. manual.

Our engineering work in wet storage (Part 50), however, continues to be conducted under the latest revision. (Rev. 12) of the manual. We will adopt Revision 12 as the single, united governing Q.A. Manual for all corporate activities as soon as SFPO's review of Rev. 12 is completed with an affirmative outcome.

We appreciate this opportunity to clarify the remaining issue.
