In a letter dated June 14, 2001, the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Con Edison), provided to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) changes to certain Technical Specifications (TSs) Bases sections for Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 2. Specifically, Con Edison provided changes to the Bases for TS 3.3, "Engineered Safety Features," TS 3.5, "Instrumentation Systems," TS 3.8, "Refueling, Fuel Storage, and Operations with the Reactor Vessel Head Bolts Less than Fully Tensioned," and TS 4.5, "Engineered Safety Features." Con Edison stated that the changes were processed in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.59.
