**PROGRAM MANAGEMENT INFORMATION: REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON A DRAFT  
PROPOSED RULE FOR REVISION OF THE SKIN DOSE LIMIT (STP-01-035)**

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is announcing the availability of, and requesting comments on, a draft proposed rule which would amend NRC's regulations relating to occupational skin dose limits.

The proposed rule has been uploaded to the NRC's Technical Conference Forum (TCF) under a subsystem where access is limited to Agreement States.
