

10	comments. First of all, on the first page of my April
11	24, 2001 letter, on the third line from the bottom it
12	says Indian Point Stations 2 and 3. That's a mistake.
13	It should only be Indian Point Station Unit 2. I had
14	made an error assembling the list.
15	MS. BLACK: Okay, we'll strike Indian
16	Point 3.
