Dear Mr. Lynch:

I am writing to memorialize our conversations during the July 20, 2001, Enforcement Meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss what corrective action would be taken to abate the violations observed during the Department's November 30, 2000, inspection.

You indicated that you have contacted approximately six companies to obtain quotes for the sorting and packaging of the radioactive/hazardous wastes stored at the facility.

The possibility exists that the mixed wastes may be treated onsite to render them non-hazardous. If the waste is rendered non-hazardous, the violations observed regarding the mixed waste would be resolved and could facilitate additional disposal options, substantially reducing disposal costs. I encourage you to explore this possibility when meeting with consulting firms.

I expressed to you that the Department would like to enter into a Consent Order and Agreement that would provide for the characterization, separation and treatment or removal of the mixed waste currently stored at your facility. To this end I would like for you to submit to me a letter indicating when you can have time frames for the completion of the following objectives:


1. Receive quotes from qualified contractors that would include separation, packaging, treatment and/or removal of the wastes.
2. Award a contract for the work outlined in Objective 1 above.
3. Initiate the work outlined in Objective 1 above.
4. Complete the work outlined in Objective 1 above.



Please respond to me by August 3, 2001, as to when you can provide me with time frames for the actions listed in Objectives 1 through 4 above.
