SUBJECT: NAC-UMS CASK SYSTEM, AMENDMENT 2 RULEMAKING

I am forwarding proposed Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 1015, Amendment No. 2, and the preliminary Safety Evaluation Report (SER) for the NAC-UMS Universal Storage System, for inclusion with the direct final rulemaking package for this cask. The proposed CoC, Technical Specifications (appendices to the CoC) and preliminary SER have been placed in ADAMS (see reference below) and are available for your use in the rulemaking package. The Spent Fuel Project Office will designate these documents as Official Agency Records after the EDO approves publication of the direct final rulemaking.

The proposed changes to the certificate (including its appendices) are indicated by vertical lines on the margin of the certificate. The changes proposed for Amendment No. 2 include: (1) changes to authorized contents to allow Maine Yankee to store various components associated with the spent fuel assemblies; (2) a Technical Specification change to delete the requirement to place a TSC in the transfer cask if the associated VCC's vents cannot be unblocked; and (3) editorial clarifications, administrative changes and correction of discrepancies in the Technical Specifications (TS).
