Mr. Marvin Mendonca has requested clarification and more definitive information concerning the transfer of the Aerotest Radiography and Research Reactor (ARRR) license from OEA, Inc., to Autoliv ASP, Inc. To the best of our knowledge, the information is:

- A. Autoliv ASP incorporation? Incorporated in Indiana in 1989; Autoliv, Inc., in Delaware in 1997.
- B. Decommissioning cost guarantee: Autoliv ASP will guarantee the decommissioning fund per 10CFR30, Appendix A, and has
 - 1. More than 90% of its assets in the U.S.
 - 2. At least six times the current decommissioning cost in total assets
 - 3. Tangible net worth of at least \$10 million
- C. Control of all activities by U. S. citizens: All ARRR activities will be under the control of U. S. citizens. There will be no foreign indebtedness nor interlocking directors or officers of foreign corporations.
- D. The formal letter from the parent company guaranteeing the decommissioning fund will be forwarded to you as soon as we receive the document.

Thank you for your help in our license transfer from OEA, Inc., to Autoliv ASP, Inc. We look forward to meeting with you later this month.
