At the afternoon session of July 17, 2001, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) public meeting in Homestead, Florida the NRC staff agreed to provide you with some current testimony presented to Congress regarding the renewal of the Price-Anderson Act. Enclosed is a copy of a statement submitted on May 24, 2001, to the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. In that statement the Commission unanimously recommends that the Price-Anderson Act be renewed with only minor modifications.
