Dear Mr. Broome:

The annual performance assessment of the McGuire Nuclear Station has been completed in accordance with the NRC Reactor Oversight Process, using the most recent performance indicators and inspection findings from the last 12 months. The assessment reflects current licensee performance and is described in the enclosed Annual Assessment Letter sent to the Duke Energy Corporation on May 31, 2001.

On July 10, 2001, members of my staff will meet with the management of the Duke Energy Corporation to discuss the performance of McGuire. This meeting is scheduled to be conducted at 1:00 p.m., at the McGuire site (12700 Hagers Ferry Road, Huntersville, NC) in the South Administration Building (number 7438), Room 155.

I would like to personally invite you to attend this Annual Assessment Meeting. Also in conjunction with this meeting, I would like to invite you to a separate meeting between you and other State and local government officials, and my staff. This meeting will be conducted at the same location shortly after the conclusion of the Annual Assessment Meeting. The purposes of this meeting are to meet the NRC inspectors at McGuire, and to ensure that you are aware of the NRC inspection and assessment process and the avenues that are available to bring concerns that you or your constituents have to the NRC. This meeting will also provide you the opportunity to inform us of any current personal or constituent concerns with McGuire. There is also another means for you to become familiar with the Reactor Oversight Process and the specific performance of McGuire. Your schedule permitting, my staff looks forward to meeting with you on July 10, 2001. In the interim, please do not hesitate to contact me directly or Mr. Malcolm Widmann of my staff if we
