SUBJECT: MODIFICATION NO. 1 TO TASK ORDER NO. 3 ENTITLED, "SEVERE ACCIDENT AND THERMAL-HYDRAULIC CODE ASSESSMENT AND PHENOMENOLOGICAL ISSUES" UNDER CONTRACT NO. NRC-04-97-040

The purpose of this modification is to (1) reinstate and extend the period of performance of the subject task order through May 31, 2002, at no additional cost or obligation to the Government. NOTE: No costs will be allowed for the period in which the task order was not in effect (May 21, 2001 to the present). The extension is necessary to allow the contractor to provide supplemental assessment work in the area of severe accident codes and thermal-hydraulic codes, and (2) revise the NRC contact person for contractual matters under the task order. Accordingly, the task order is hereby revised as follows:

- (1) The second paragraph of the basic task order is deleted in its entirety and the following paragraph is substituted in lieu thereof:

"Task Order No. 3 shall be in effect from May 22, 2000, through May 31, 2002. The total estimated ceiling for this task order of \$55,657.85. NOTE: NO COSTS WILL BE ALLOWED FOR THE PERIOD IN WHICH THE TASK ORDER WAS NOT IN EFFECT (MAY 21, 2001 TO JULY 17, 2001.)"

All other terms and conditions of the subject task order remain unchanged.



