Gentlemen:

In the Application submitted with the referenced letter, TXU Electric Company ("TXU Electric") requested, pursuant to Section 184 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended ("Act"), and 10 CFR § 50.80, that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") consent to the direct transfer of control of TXU Electric's operating authority and 100% ownership interest in the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2 ("CPSES") on January 1, 2002, to a Texas limited partnership, TXU Genco, TLP. TXU Electric also requested that the NRC issue the required conforming administrative amendments to the CPSES licenses. The purpose of this letter is to describe a revision to that Application and revision to the financial statements submitted with the Application.

The revision submitted herein is described in the following enclosures: Enclosure 1 is an Affidavit of Roger D. Walker which describes, on behalf of TXU Electric, a request that Enclosures 3 and 4 be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR § 2.790 because Enclosures 3 and 4 contain confidential commercial or financial information which is considered proprietary. Enclosure 2 provides a non-

proprietary version of the revised financial statements suitable for public disclosure. Enclosure 3 describes the revision to the Application. Enclosure 4 provides the revised financial statements incorporating this revision. The confidential Addendum to this letter contains proprietary Enclosures 3 and 4.

The remainder of the Application is unchanged, and the original "Safety Analysis" (Attachment 1 of the Application) which includes the "No Significant Hazards" evaluation remains valid.

AFFIDAVIT OF ROGER D. WALKER

I, Roger D. Walker, Regulatory Affairs Manager at TXU Electric Company ("TXU Electric"), do hereby affirm and state:

- 1. I am authorized to execute this affidavit on behalf of TXU Electric.
- 2. TXU Electric is providing information in support of its Application for Order Consenting to License Transfers and Approving Conforming Administrative License Amendments. The documents being provided in Enclosures 3 and 4 contain business plans and financial projections related to the ownership and operation of TXU Electric's generation assets, including the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2 ("CPSES"). These documents constitute proprietary commercial and financial information that should be held in confidence by the NRC pursuant to the policy reflected in 10 CFR §§ 2.790(a)(4) and 9.17(a)(4), because:
 - i. This information is and has been held in confidence by TXU Electric.
 - ii. This information is of a type that is held in confidence by TXU Electric and there is a rational basis for doing so because the information contains sensitive financial information concerning the projected revenues and operating expenses of TXU Electric and its successors and affiliates.
 - iii. This information is being transmitted to the NRC in confidence.
 - iv. This information is not available in public sources and could not be gathered readily from other publicly available information.
 - v. Public disclosure of this information would create substantial harm to the competitive position of TXU Electric and its successors and affiliates by disclosing their internal financial projects.
- 3. Accordingly, TXU Electric requests that the designated documents be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to the policy reflected in 10 CFR §§ 2.790(a)(4) and 9.17(a)(4).
