Summary Of Monthly Operating Experience

- Hope Creek started the month at approximately 100% power.
- On July 14, power was reduced to 86% for scheduled control valve testing and repairs to the 6A feedwater heater drain system. Power was restored to 100% on July 15.
- On July 16, power was reduced to approximately 70% to perform planned leak detection on the B Condenser north waterbox. Power was restored to 100% on July 17.
- On July 20, power was reduced to 91% for the 5021 Deans Line Outage.
 Hope Creek returned to 100% power on July 21.
- On July 25, power was reduced to approximately 83% for control rod recovery and returned to 100% power on July 26.
- At the end of July, Hope Creek completed 76 days of continuous on-line operation.
