

Fitness-For-Duty Six Month Performance Data Report
January 1, 2001, through June 30, 2001**

FITNESS-FOR-DUTY PROGRAM SUMMARY:

- During the reporting period, January 1, 2001, through June 30, 2001, the River Bend Station random testing rate was approximately 29.5% percent.
- A total of three hundred and ninety-eight (398) specimens were collected during this reporting period. Blind performance specimens were shipped at a rate of 12%.

POSITIVE RESULTS:

- One contract employee tested positive for marijuana during pre-access screening.

MANAGEMENT ACTIONS:

- Access was denied for the contract employee who tested positive for marijuana. Management was notified and this individual's file was annotated to reflect the positive result and the actions taken.
- Two employees participated in the follow-up program during this reporting period and six follow-up tests were administered to these employees.

FITNESS-FOR-DUTY INITIATIVES TAKEN:

- In March/April 2001, Fitness-For-Duty personnel from River Bend Station assisted Grand Gulf Nuclear Station during ramp-up for their Refuel Outage 11.

EFFECTIVENESS EVALUATION/AUDITS:

- On March 31, 2001, the NRC completed an inspection of the Fitness-For-Duty and Access Authorization Programs. Areas reviewed were procedures, audits, and self-assessments of behavior observation, access authorization, fitness for duty, supervisor and escort training, and re-qualification training. No findings of significance were identified.
- The Fitness-For-Duty Program will continue to update and revise procedures based on the Final Rule, 10 CFR Part 26, operating experiences, lessons learned, NRC audits, and benchmarking other nuclear sites.

REPORTABLE FFD EVENTS:

- There were no reportable events or problems identified within the River Bend Station Fitness-For-Duty Program during this reporting period.
